## **TEACHING EXPERIENCE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Overview:**

Since joining the LSU School of Medicine faculty, I have been extensively involved in the education of the medical students and residents. I have been responsible for educating residents, third and fourth-year students on the inpatient and outpatient internal medicine services. I am responsible for educating approximately 40 residents per academic year on the identification, pathophysiology and management of acute and chronic conditions affecting adults. This includes bedside rounds, supervision in the ambulatory clinics, and 2-3 noon lectures per academic year. Eight months of the year, I attend the inpatient medicine service and typically have two third-year and two fourth-year students, two interns, and one upper-level resident on each team. On the outpatient side, I staff the resident primary care clinic two to three half days of the week. Each clinic has anywhere from two to four third and fourth-year students and four to six residents that I am responsible for supervising and educating. Aside from my clinical duties, I have lectured third-year internal medicine clerkship students in Baton Rouge and Lafayette on various topics in the “Flipped Classroom” and traditional lecture formats. I also lead small-group sessions in the first-year medical curriculum as a faculty member of the Houses program and the Clinical Sciences Integration (CSI) course. Further details of my educational efforts and responsibilities are described below.
