The fellows will be a resource for direct resident and student teaching and supervision in sports medicine and general family medicine. The fellows will gain broad exposure to sports medicine including the following: injury prevention strategies, injury evaluation, diagnosis, and restoration of function through rehabilitation or surgical means. The fellows are exposed to athletic coverage at the professional, collegiate and high school level. The curriculum consists of: a formal academic education consisting of weekly conferences and didactic teaching, and research opportunity is available for both clinical and basic science.
