

## Applying to Pediatric Fellowship

- **Important Websites**

    - Where to actually apply (ERAS)
    - Has list of each subspecialty and what programs are participating in the match
  - <http://www.nrmp.org/fellow/index.html>
    - Where to register for match and find out specifics about when dates open for subspecialties
    - Also known as Subspecialty match services (SMS)
- **Letters of Recommendation**
  - Need a letter from your program director Dr. Desselle (Dr. Lo if you are Med/Peds)
  - Also look at the NRMP website to see what additional requirements different programs have
  - Need 3-4 letters of rec
- **From Your Med School**
  - Need MSPE, transcript
  - Must upload your own photo – make sure it is a full head shot and light background
  - LSU Grads – Talk to Ms. Lindy – she can help with the above

**NOTE:** The following information pertains to fellowships at LSUHSC-NO (Children's Hospital). These details are subject to change; please refer to program website for most up-to-date information.

- **At CHNOLA**
  - Kelly Allerton is in charge of downloading all applications and fellowship coordinator; she is also in charge of setting up interview for all subspecialty fellowships except cards.
- **Adolescent Medicine**
  - Apply: starting July 1<sup>st</sup> of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Register for Match: August of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank order list opens: September of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank list due: beginning of November of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Match: end of November of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- **Allergy/Immunology**
  - Apply: starting July 1<sup>st</sup> of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Register for Match: End of July of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank order list opens: October of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank list due: beginning of November of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Match: beginning of December of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - LSU Program Director: Dr. Paris
  - Interviews around 10 for 1-2 spots between Aug-Sep

- **Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine**
  - Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine has decided to change recruitment cycle from second to third year, giving residents more time to explore and solidify their career options. This sub-specialty will begin receiving ERAS applications in July 2014 for training that starts July 2015. These programs will NOT participate in ERAS 2014, since they will have already filled positions for July 2014.
  - In addition to Letter of Recommendations, need to give letter writers form from the following website: <http://www2.aap.org/sections/perinatal/ONTPDfiles/NPMLoR.pdf>
  - LSU Program Director: Dr. Penn and Associate program director is Dr. Rivera
    - Interview about 5 per year and accept 1-2 per year
    - Hopefully will be interviewing Aug-Sept of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  
- **Pediatric Hematology/Oncology**
  - Apply: November of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Register for Match: December of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Rank order list opens: Jan of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Rank list due: end of April of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Match: May of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Program Director: Dr. Yu
  - Interview about 15 per year in Jan-Feb of 2<sup>nd</sup> year; take 1-2 year
  
- **Pediatric Specialties Fall Match (Developmental-Behavioral Pediatrics , Pediatric Critical Care Medicine , Pediatric Emergency Medicine , Pediatric Nephrology , Pediatric Rheumatology )**
  - Apply: starting July 1<sup>st</sup> of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Register for Match: August of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank order list opens: October of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Rank list due: mid November of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Match: end of November of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Nephrology program director: Dr. Aviles
    - Take 1 every other year; interview 3-5 per year
  
- **Pediatric Specialties Spring Match (Pediatric Cardiology, Pediatric Endocrinology, Pediatric Gastroenterology, Pediatric Infectious Diseases , Pediatric Pulmonology)**
  - Apply: starting November of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Register for Match: January of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Rank order list opens: April of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Rank list due: beginning of May of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - Match: end of May of 2<sup>nd</sup> year
  - ID: Tulane mainly but if interested talk with Dr. Begue or Seybolt
  - Cards: interview Jan-Feb of 2<sup>nd</sup> year; interview about 10 per year and take 1-2 per year
    - Dr. Nancy is program director
    - Carol Lemay is the secretary that coordinates interviews
  - Endocrine: interview Jan-Mar <5 per year for 1 spot; Dr. Gomez program director
  - GI: interview Jan-April about 5 applicants match 1; Dr. Keith is program director
  
- **Child Abuse**
  - Apply: July 1<sup>st</sup> of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Beginning to use SMS July 2014

- **Sports Medicine**

- Apply: July 1<sup>st</sup> of 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- Not using SMS currently so if interested in a program contact program directly
- Using ERAS though
